Master Course Pediatric Oncology 2021 - 2023

This course is an excellent opportunity for medical professionals and scientists who wish to be trained in pediatric oncology at the advanced level. Moreover, the Master Course will enable you to build your own international network and meet experts in the field.

The Master Course is organized by the Princess Máxima Center for Pediatric Oncology (Utrecht, The Netherlands). It consists of four modules which can be followed over the course of 2 years: general aspects, hemato-oncology, neuro-oncology and solid tumors.



Program and learning objectives

Each module consists of two live days accompanied by a comprehensive online program covering key concepts that can be followed in a self-paced manner. During the live days, topics are explored in greater depth during handson sessions such as tumor boards. workshops, escape rooms and expert sessions. Participants will be trained to apply knowledge in clinical practice. In addition, preclinical and translational research will be covered as well. We advise to attend all four modules, but it is possible to register for selected modules as well. An application has been made to the UEMS EACCME® for CME accreditation of this event.
