

## The war in Ukraine

In only a few weeks of time, the war in Ukraine has led to a human tragedy of unprecedented proportions in modern time on the European mainland. There are no signs that this tragedy will come to an end soon; in fact the prospects for Ukraine are dim. For instance, this could concern support of refugees from Ukraine who are seeking work or education in Clinical Pharmacology in the Netherlands. Our network can both be used by colleagues from Ukraine and by colleagues/members from our society who are willing to support.
